This term we will be teaching *Freedom in Christ (FIC)*. FIC is a bible course designed to help us become more mature and fruitful disciples of Jesus through:

- discovering scriptural truths about our identity and authority in Christ
- partnering with God in the renewal of our minds
- Becoming attuned to Bible truth rather than Enemy lies
- dealing with emotions & understanding forgiveness
- Learning how to keep going strong in the faith to the end of our lives.

How will we teach the course?

The FIC teaching will be delivered in 3 main ways:

- 1) Our Sunday sermons will cover the 13 sessions that make up the course.
- 2) We will then be holding central evenings for further teaching, worship, group work and prayer on the following Wednesday evening at 7.30pm for coffee (meeting starts at 7.45pm).
- 3) If you are in a small group for whom the central Wednesdays are not suitable your group can work through the follow-up material week by week.

Why come to the central evenings?

As well as following the course material, the central evenings will allow us to:

- explore aspects of mature, fruitful discipleship (listening to God, developing the fruits of the Spirit, spiritual warfare and becoming more effective as a witness to the good news).
- meet with others from across the church family

So we can grow in faith, meet new people and deepen and strengthen existing friendships.
