The Location

We are going to a new venue this year. Hebron Hall Christian Centre is on the outskirts of the village of Dinas Powys, Wales, about 4 miles from Cardiff.

Hebron Hall is very spacious with a large conference hall for our talks and lots of space for breaking out into small groups. For the more energetic there is a heated 15 metre indoor swimming pool, a sports hall for 5 a side football, badminton and volley ball, a table tennis room and an outdoor tennis court.



Accommodation & Cost

The cost of the weekend is per person and covers accommodation and all meals. All bedrooms are en-suite. In order to keep costs to a minimum Hebron Hall provide duvets & pillows. Bed linen & towels are available at a small additional cost or you may bring your own.
