## Sun 18th December - Serving mulled wine

Welcoming guests to the 11.15am Christmas Day service. 4-6 people required from 10.50am.

A team of volunteers is needed to help with the lunch on Christmas Day. Tasks including helping with food, setting up, welcoming guest, running a quiz, washing up or hosting tables. Help will be required between about 9am and 4pm.
